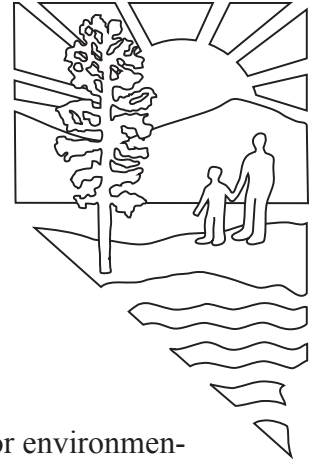

NNREC works with land management agencies, schools, nonprofit organizations and a variety other interested parties, to create professional development opportunities for teachers and nonformal educators, and other projects that expand the capacity of all partners to offer environmental education in Nevada. For example, the Nevada Division of Forestry funds Project Learning Tree workshops offered by NNREC throughout the state, and a significant portion of the Lamoille Institute for Educators summer workshop. Partners provide funding and/or in-kind services to NNREC for these specific projects and opportunities.

With challenges such as the paucity of hands-on, inquiry based education in the schools, rapid population growth, questions about water supply and quality, and increasing recreation and resource demands on our public lands, an environmentally literate and active citizenry is a critical part of the solution and a common goal of many in the state. NNREC provides leadership and coordination of environmental education in Nevada to enhance the efforts of all partners and fulfill the common elements of the partner's missions.

NNREC is looking to partner with additional organizations, leveraging funding to support a Director position, office space, transportation and day-to-day operations. These items are critical in continuing our efforts in professional development and providing programs and funding to educators throughout the state.
